

## **ROAD SAFETY POLICY**

## **EDP ESPAÑA COMMITMENT**

In keeping with the EDP Group's Occupational Health & Safety Policy, which establishes that the health and safety of everybody involved in the activities of the companies of the EDP Group — workers, suppliers, service providers, customers and other stakeholders — is a fundamental value and a priority for the success of EDP as a business group, EDP ESPAÑA, committed to ensuring efficiency in routine operations and continuous improvement in safety management and performance, has established the need to set a common framework to control and manage road safety hazards, by means of a Road Safety Management System based on ISO 39001.

## **GUIDING PRINCIPLES:**

To fulfil that commitment:

- 1. The members of the Senior Management are committed to road safety, by showing active leadership and driving the safety culture; they have therefore established policies, goals and targets in that regard.
- 2. The Senior Management guarantees compliance of legal requirements and others voluntarily assumed by the EDP Group.
- 3. All the employees of our organisation will lead the actions that foster road safety.
- 4. Therefore, impetus is given to maintaining and improving the involvement of the staff, by fostering training, sills and awareness-raising.
- 5. The continuous improvement of the road safety management system is always present in order to improve road safety performance and reduce the incidence of and the risk of death and serious injuries from traffic accidents.
- 6. We urge our contractors, suppliers and other interest groups to actively participate in the continuous improvement of road safety culture.
